

Udržateľnosť malých a rodinných fariem - Sustainability of Small and Family Farms (SOILS) 2016-1-SK01-KA203-022611

Report from the Transnational Project Meeting Kick-off meeting Slovak University of Agriculture in Nitra, Slovakia May 31, 2017

Within the project "Sustainability of Small and Family Farms — Udržateľnosť malých a rodinných fariem" (SOILS), no. 2016-1-SK01-KA203-022611, the first transnational project kick-off meeting was held on May 31, 2017 at the Faculty of Economics and Management, Slovak University of Agriculture in Nitra, where 6 project partners took part from Slovakia, Czech Republic and Hungary. The project partner from Lithuania presented their materials through a Skype call. Participants discussed the program and important questions related to the project about main project activities, their distribution, financial issues and project documentation. Each project partner presented the agriculture of their country during the meeting. Each presentation took 20 minutes and the situation in Slovakia, Czech Republic, Hungary and Lithuania was described. After the presentations, the discussion continued about the agricultural sectors. The participants discussed the particular project outputs, especially "The Methodology of Farms Evaluation", within which the topics were compared and calculation of plant and animal commodities reviewed. Also, the activities and tasks for the next project output "Analyses of Small Farms in the Central European Space" were outlined.
