Report form Transnational Project Meeting

September 18-20, 2018

Within the project “Sustainability of Small and Family Farms (SOILS) – Udržitelnost' malých a rodinných farem”, No. 2016-1-SK01-KA203-022611, the second Transnational Project Meeting was held in Prague, Czech Republic on 18.-.20. September, 2018 organised by Společnost mladých agráriků České republiky. It was organized in the lecture room of the Czech University of Life Science.

The main aim of the meeting was to discuss about partial project results (output 2) and their finalisation, divide tasks within the 3rd part of implementation where the software product will be created as a project result (output 3). Partner from SUA in Nitra presented the structure and collected data within a partial result. All participants had possibility to share their opinion how to make this model useful for small farmers in the project countries.

The meeting was constructive and full of productive communication and collaboration among representor's of universities and young farmers' organisations. Everybody expressed their opinion and experience about small and family farmers' situation in project partners' countries, gave suggestions for the improvement of project stages and anticipated results.

Except project results and tasks, questions about budget, project documentation and another tasks joined with the project management were discussed.

Participants of the meeting attended international conference AGRARIAN PERSPECTIVES XXVII. and also visited market of vegetables and tea grasses.

Food Safety and Food Security were the central topics of the 27th conference Agrarian Perspectives held at the Faculty of Economics and Management of the Czech University of Life Sciences Prague from 19th to 20th September 2018. In the Food Security, the topics such as the national food security in the context of international trade, but also the problems of food
