

One day trip: Natural and Cultural Slovak Heritage
(28th May, 2010)

The field trip is going to start with the visit of Vaľecká cave located between Liptovský Mikuláš and Poprad (Liptov region). The cave represents an important palaeontological place of cave bear bones (*Ursus spelaeus*), which was bigger and heavier than present brown bear. The sculpture in life size is newly installed in the cave. The traditional village Vaľec is situated under the famous Tatra mountains.



Then the participants will travel by bus through the mountain road and on the top there is a beautiful panorama with a view on the Liptov region.

The trip will continue with a lunch in the restaurant Koliba JOSU (www.kolibajosu.sk) built in traditional folk



architecture of northern Orava. They serve culinary specialties and beverages from the Orava region.

The final part of the trip will offer to foreign guests a “brief touch” with the history by the visit of the Orava castle (www.oravamuzeum.sk) that will end with a little surprise...
